Our relationship with God

Last Sunday, March 31

During the Sabbath dinner at the home of one of the Pharisaic leaders, Jesus uses parables to teach table manners (and deeper truths) applicable to both guests and hosts. Jesus' proclamation that the time of Jubilee has come (Lk 4:16-21) sets his followers free, both then and now, from entrenched social roles and hierarchies. With this good news, we are empowered to live with joyful humility and hospitable hearts, understanding that each and every one of us has a "place of honor" in the Reign of God.

Nursery and Play Area Age Limits

Due to the number of young children we have, our current nursery facility is very crowded many Sundays. (This is a good problem to have!) We would like to suggest an age limit for the nursery of 0-3 years. To help our 4 and 5-year olds adjust, a child-friendly area is being set up at the back of the sanctuary in the area where the Giving Corner has been located. (Don't worry, the Giving Corner – renamed "Sharing Space" – isn't gone. Check at the bottom of the basement steps...) This child's area is meant for those young children who might have troubhle sitting through the entire worship service without a little additional

movement (suggested age: pre-school). There will be some quiet toys/activities at a table, floor pillows for a change of sitting in the pews and a rocking chair. We do ask that parents oversee their children while in the area so that running and loud talking/noise is discouraged.

Other plans for the nursery include removing one of the two cribs and adding a larger table and chairs. This will allow more room for children to spread out and engage in a variety of play. We would also like to trade the rocking chair for a glider. If anyone knows where we could find one for a reasonable cost, please let on of us know. Structure Evaluation

Shalom's organization/structure has been serving us for about a year and a half and it's time for a performance review. The VAT (Vision & Accountability Team, our governing body) has asked Sam Bixler and Cheryl Martin to conduct this evaluation. They will meet with the VAT, the Spiritual Gifts Discernment Team, the Pastoral Team, and each of the commissions to learn how the structure is working in those settings. Then the congregation will be surveyed to provide indivudal input - how well is our structure working for you? When all the information has been gathered, it will be shared in aggregate with the VAT and with the congregation in a group meeting. Proposales for tweaks or major changes may be proposed, depending on results of the feedback from the evaluation. No time has been set for the congregational meeting, but it should take place soon after the survey is completed.
