Suggestions were made as to what might be changed now or in preparation for another period of lockdown. They include: keep in mind that individuals have different levels of comfort using technology, welcome participants on Zoom by name because persons worshipping in person do not know who is with us on Zoom, use the phone more to stay in touch, plan for informal visiting or other events on Zoom outside of Sunday morning and have more outdoor activities or worship experiences.

Including Youth with Autism

The latest Anabaptist Disabilities Network Newsletter highlights inclusion of those with autism in congregations. One article, written by a young woman with autism, poignantly describes talking to God as a nonverbal person. In another, the mother of a son with autism shares joys as well as getting caught in the trap of "The Comparison Game." A high school Sunday school teacher who is also a special ed teacher writes about including individuals with difficult behaviors. His article concludes with the challenge to all of us in the church: "The youth try to inform us to live up to the promise of Jesus that all are welcome. If we do not see those faces, tolerate those outbursts, or fully embrace the differences in God's Garden, are we then the welcome ones?"
